



Morning Arrival and transfer to Hotel in Ouaga or to Motorcoach. 356 km ~5-6 hour drive

After breakfast in Ouaga, motor coaches depart for **Bobo Dioulasso** ("house of the Bobo merchants"), Burkina Faso's second largest city. Stop at approx. 80 km to visit the sacred crocodiles' pond in Sabou and learn about the legend of these animals. This pond is visited quite frequently by national and international visitors. It is a charming place where men and animals coexist in a paradoxical harmony. Time permitting visit the local tapestry of Sabou before continuing to Bobo enjoying the countryside of Burkina Faso as we travel southward, into the arguably the best culturally preserved area of West Africa. Explore Bobo in the morning including their **famous mosque**. A guide will take you inside the mosque and to the place where they call for prayer. Visit the old **Kibidwe Artisans' District**, where we will see blacksmiths, potters, and dyers at work. We will also see the **sacred catfish** and the place where they make the local beer; here people are animist and worship fetish. Visit the place where they discuss important matters, see the sacred catfish and dance at the rhythm of a local musicians group. Continue to the market and admire the products of the craft men. In the afternoon, drive to **Koumi** a traditional village where life seems to be stopped centuries and ancient practice kept from generation to generation. It is here that during the dry season the young Bobo boys are circumcised and initiated into manhood. You may meet the new initiated that wear no clothes.

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
